

# Providing Nexon Granular Delegated Admin Permissions (GDAP)



## What is GDAP?

GDAP is a security feature that provides partners with least-privileged access following the Zero Trust cybersecurity protocol released by Microsoft.

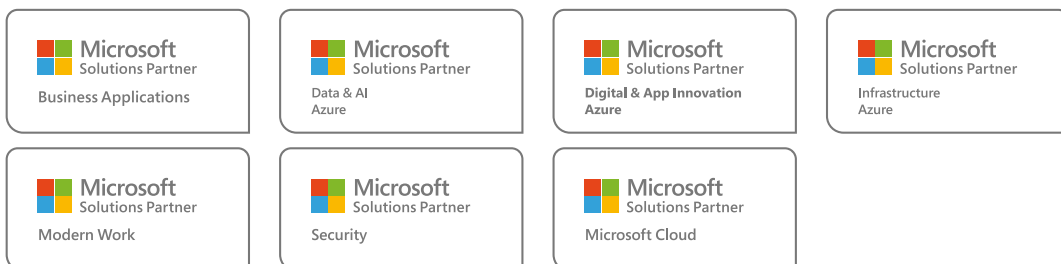
GDAP provides Nexon with more precise and time-bound access to your workloads. This approach enhances security measures by addressing concerns without requiring elevated partner access levels.

- ✔ User access is under named accounts providing auditability and full visibility to both Customer and Nexon with the ability to control and grant permissions specifically and limited to only the access needed.
- ✔ Nexon operates a separate domain for Partner Access (thecavalry.com.au) to provide complete separation for Nexon employees to all other data and systems they have access to and removes the threat of compromise should there be a breach or unauthorised access attempt.
- ✔ Immediate ability to revoke access by Nexon and Customers.
- ✔ MFA and Geo-blocking is applied by Nexon to thecavalry.com.au logins so access is only used from verified locations and devices.

If access is not already in place, your Nexon Account Manager will reach out to you to kick off the Partner of Record and manage the rest from there!

As a Microsoft partner, Nexon is required to record the work we are completing for our clients to maintain our Solution Partner designation.
